This year special awards have been dedicated to the Diamond Jubilee of Queen Elizabeth II.

Usually it has been named after a person who has given honourable service to the Association. It was felt by all that the magnificent reign of her majesty and her service to us was more appropriate to commemorate this very noble occasion.



It is offered in all grades at the same entry fee as last year at Rainbow, One Dance, Bronze, Silver, Gold and Gold Cross and above levels with a full range of medals.

The award is a one off multi dance examination. The number of dances is quoted below. The choice of dances is left to the pupil.

BALLROOM, LATIN AMERICAN, SEQUENCE, FREESTYLE/STREET, COUNTRY & WESTERN, CLUB DANCING, ROCK 'N' ROLL

Awards outlined as follows:-

ONE DANCE - PUPILS TO DANCE 1 DANCE OF CHOICE.

RAINBOW - PUPILS TO DANCE 2 DANCES OF CHOICE
(Rainbow Standard)

BRONZE - 2 DANCES OF CHOICE
(Available to any pupil holding a bronze medal, Grade 2, grade 3 or popular dance tests)

SILVER - 3 DANCES OF CHOICE
(Available to any pupil holding a silver medal)

GOLD - 4 DANCES OF CHOICE
(Available to any pupil holding a qualification gold or above)

GOLD CROSS & ABOVE - 4 DANCES OF CHOICE
(Available to any pupil holding a gold cross or above)

This award must be taken at the highest level already held by the candidate, Report Form to state grade held by pupil. Successful candidates will receive a Report Form and a Medal, which will be engraved with the date and their name.
